Continuing to identify gaps in management of drought, scaling up good practices, adapting protocols, and creating tools, including forecast based EWS tools to help communities to anticipate and react to future droughts

2. To build on the learnings and windows of opportunity generated by recent disasters

Work on DRR to consolidate and scale up proven DP actions with transfer knowledge and local driven rapid response capacities

3. To facilitate an interconnected and complementary approach in DP

Regional response mechanism is strengthened by operational agreements of collaboration between countries to facilitate early action

All DRR actions should foster partnership and integration in regional and national strategies
